## DEVELOPMENT, VACCINATION RECORD AND DELIVERY ARRANGEMENTS

The bulls and heifers were pasture weaned on an AccuRation/corn mix and grass. They stayed at the ranch until Oct. 10 when they were brought home and put on a TMR ration consisting of ground hay, corn silage, earlage and a liquid protein and Rumensin supplement. All the calves have been vaccinated, starting at birth, again at grass turnout, weaning and post weaning. Vaccinations include 7-way, clostridial type A, IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV, mycoplasma, haemophilus somnus, pastuerella and Dectomax injection this spring, and Dectomax Pour-on this fall. If you would like specific dates and details on the products, please give one of us a call.

The bull calves were weighed on Oct. 26 and again on Dec. 8. The average weight on Dec. 8 was 877 lbs. with an average gain of 3.47 lbs. per day. The bull calves will be sold as guaranteed breeders according to the RAAA sale terms and conditions. We will keep all bull calves free of charge until March 1, 2013, at which time they will be semen tested and delivered or picked up. You can arrange to continue having the bulls fed at a rate of \$3.50 per day with all bulls needing to be delivered by April 1, 2013.

The heifer calves have been brucellosis vaccinated and will be sold as guaranteed breeders according to the sale terms and conditions of the RAAA. Open heifers need to be picked up or delivered by Jan. 10, 2013.

Deliveries will be coordinated to the least possible cost to the buyer. If you are not hauling your own cattle, we will collect trucking fees at time of purchase settlement. Delivery will begin Jan. 2, 2013, on females, and March 1, 2013, on bulls. If you are bringing a trailer and want to haul for others, we will gladly line you up with trucking in your direction at the fee structure below. We will offer the first 1,000 miles trucking on every animal at the following rates.





Since 2010, the Red Angus Association of America (RAAA) and the American Simmental Association (ASA) have combined their growth and carcass datasets to provide commercial producers with the most reliable EPDs in the beef industry. In the summer of 2012, RAAA and ASA adopted a common base for Growth (BW, WW, YW, Milk) and Carcass (MARB, YG, CW, REA, FAT) EPDs so that all animals registered in either RAAA or ASA can be directly compared – regardless of breed makeup.

## What is BASE?

For decades, each breed association has presented EPDs in their own language (the base). Base is no more than a reference point for any trait against which subsequent generations of animals are compared. ## Study Percentile Ranks...
