



This feminine, sweet-fronted heifer is double bred to Greg and Al bred to Ardrossan Jamberoo FM6569 on 7/21/13.





Red and white bull calf 8A39 born 8/9/13 sired by Red Label. Breezy adds that extra dimension to her flashy red and white bull calf.






Chaos is long and thick with worlds of potential. His dam was the top show heifer in the Lenhard herd. He has that show stopper look!



A medium-framed bull that's thick and meaty, Chipolte is a red halfblood by Habanero out of a Red Angus base.






He is as nice a purebred bull as you can find - really well built with good growth for a purebred. He is a great herdsire prospect for first calf heifers.




