Complete dispersal of 29 percentage Lowline cows with halfblood Akaushi calves at side. The cows are 3 to 6 years old. There are 20 halfblood Lowline cows, weighing 850 - 1050#. The rest of the cows are 3/4 - purebred Lowline, weighing 800 - 900#. Some of the cows

are registered Lowlines - we will sort through the papers and match them up with the cows when we work them at the sale site. If a cow has registration papers, they will be given to the buyer sale day. The cows are all-natural, wormed with diatomaceous earth in their mineral. The calves are sired by Heartbrand 9597Y, a Akaushi bull sired by a son of Big Al. The first calf was born August 10, 2014. The bull was turned in with the cows again on September 10, 2014. The calves from these cows are eligible for a 20¢ premium market contract to Heartbrand beef if parentage verified by DNA by the new owners. This is a set of terrific productive commercial Lowline females, raised



in droughty conditions in west Texas that illustrate why we call this sale "Get Back to Grass." They are designed specifically for all-natural beef production. They also could be used as extremely efficient recipient cows for a Lowline embryo transplant program and, with Lutylase, could be set up and synchronized for early September ET calves.
