DEVELOPMENT, VACCINATION RECORD AND DELIVERY ARRANGEMENTS

The bulls, heifers and steers were pasture weaned Sept. 13th on an AccuRation/ corn mix and grass. They stayed at the ranch until October 16th when we brought them home and put them on a TMR ration consisting of ground hay, corn silage, earlage and a liquid protein/rumensin supplement. All the calves have been vaccinated starting at birth, again at grass turnout, weaning and post weaning and poured/dewormed. Vaccinations include 7-way clostridial, IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV, mycoplasma, haemophilus somnus, pastuerellas. If you would like specific details on products please give one of us a call. The bull calves were weighed on September 13th and again on Dec. 5th. The average weight on Dec. 5, 2014 was 874 pounds with an average gain of 3.25 lbs. per day since weaning.

The bull calves will be sold as guaranteed breeders according to the sale terms and conditions of the RAAA. We will keep bulls free of charge until March 1, 2015 at which time they will be semen checked and need to be picked up or delivered. You can arrange to have the bulls fed at \$4.00 per day until April 1, 2015 at which time you need to come pick them up as we need pen space for cow/calf pairs. The two herd bulls sold in the sale will need to be picked up or delivered by Jan 3, 2015

The heifer calves have been brucellosis vaccinated and will be sold as guaranteed breeders according to the sale terms and conditions of RAAA. Females need to be picked up or delivered by Jan. 3, 2015.

Bred Cows will be pregnancy checked again prior to the sale. They are brucellosis vaccinated and on the same herd health program as the heifer calves.

Load out on females and herd bulls will start at 8:30 a.m. Jan 1st. Deliveries will be coordinated at the least possible cost to the buyer. We will charge whatever it costs us to deliver from our place to wherever we meet you. If you are not hauling your own cattle we will collect trucking fees at time of delivery.

All animals will be handled at the buyer's risk. We highly recommend insuring your purchases.

Lazy J Bar Ranch will reserve the right to retain 25% semen interest on all of the bulls offered in this sale.



This heifer has been on my short list of good ones (if you like performance-type cattle) since day one! Her dam has a MPPA of 109.4. Her dam had twins as a first-calf heifer, came back and stuck A.I. the next year, and now put this bell ringer on the ground this year. Did you see the growth this heifer has with WW and YW in the top 1% while Maintenance Energy is at a -2? At the time of writ-

ing footnotes (11-30-14) there were only 12 non-parent females in the RAAA registry that have a 92 or higher WW combined with a 152 or higher YW. If you narrow the search to find non-parent females with those WW and YW in addition to the ME, MARB and REA numbers, there are currently only five head total and if you search active dams with those parameters you return only four cows in the entire registry with that much growth and at least this much carcass. So she has a 3.1 BW EPD – big deal. The more I look at her numbers, you might be lucky if she is still in the sale pen come sale day. If you did your homework after the footnotes on the last lot, then you will have noticed that one of those 12 non-parent females goes back to this Bonnebelle cow family and the dam of this heifer boasts a 112.0 MPPA. Her dam was a solid producer for powerful, good milking daughters. I think to date we have raised more bull calves out of 289 than females but good commercial cattlemen

like Peter Franck didn't pass up a bull out of her dam. If you are looking for a heifer that has a balanced set of EPDs, the look of a cow maker and the ability to produce herd bulls then look no further – 4218 is your girl.
