Twenty-three years ago when I was first buying red cattle, and I would sell my steers or cull heifers at the local auction barn, the order buyers would sort the reds out. Every time they did, the calves weighed more than the average of the group they were pulled from, but would bring a lot less money. The owner of that barn at the time would tell me, "Steph, you just sit back and wait. These red cattle will outsell all the others before too long."

Well, I can tell you, it seemed like way too long as a teenager, twenty-some years ago, getting started in the cattle business to see that turn around, but boy has it turned around now. That auction barn owner passed on before he got to see the "Red Revolution" but he is one of the main reasons I stuck with this breed of cattle. These Red Angus cattle are a hot commodity today. Of course, I don't need to be telling you that because your interest already lies with Red Angus cattle.

You will notice as you look through the catalog that all the heifers are offered again this year, but there will be a little different sale format. You can read more about them by Lot 3 in the catalog. We did 50K test quite a few of the females and some bulls. We specifically tested the E.T. calves and then just randomly picked some out to test after that. You will also notice that we are offering the first of limited semen packages on the \$70,000 LSF RAB Performance 2772Z bull that we own in partnership with Kaup Red Angus, Kurtz Cattle Co., R.A. Brown Ranch and Origen. We are really excited about seeing his offspring hit the ground in a couple months. We Aled to him as well as used him as a clean up bull on about 100 head of cows. He came home

in great shape, then went to stud and froze semen. He will be a future breed changer. Don't miss out on this genetic opportunity.

We invite you to spend New Year's Eve with us. The sale will be held at the Ramada Inn, Aberdeen, S.D. via video. The cattle will be sorted up in display pens on Dec. 30 and 31. You are more than welcome to stop anytime before that to view cattle. If you are flying into Aberdeen and need transportation to the ranch, please give us a call. We would encourage you to come to the ranch and view the cattle prior to the sale. We suggest that if you are interested in bidding on cattle that you pick out a couple alternate lots as the cattle will be located 20 miles from the hotel site.

We cannot stress enough that this IS a FAMILY event so please, bring your spouse and children. There will be display booths at the hotel to check out, plus the hotel has a pool and what kids don't love to dance? We like to travel with our kids and want you to feel comfortable doing the same if you so choose.

SALE TERMS & CONDITIONS



TERMS: Terms of the sale are cash, check, sight draft or other terms agreed to in writing between seller, buyer, and sale manager payable immediately upon conclusion of the sale and before animals will be moved. Sale manager reserves the right to require a certified check as settlement before releasing any cattle.

PURCHASER'S RISK: All animals are the owner's risk prior to their sale and become property of the purchaser as soon as declared sold by the auctioneer.

BIDDING: Any disputes or challenges regarding bids or tie bids will be settled by the auctioneer and his decision will be final.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Any errors or changes in information contained in the catalog will be announced from the auction block and such announcements shall take precedence over information contained herein.

HEALTH: All animals are eligible for interstate shipment. Interstate health papers prepared by an accredited veterinarian will be furnished on each animal sold. Arrangements for International Shipments should be made with the sale manager prior to the auction. All efforts for the exportation of cattle can be arranged through sale management.

BREEDING GUARANTEE: All animals are guaranteed by the seller as outlined in the Red Angus Association of America Code of Ethical Sale Practices. Guarantees will be handled on an individual basis, with credit towards another animal.

LIABILITIES: All persons who attend the sale do so at their own risk. The seller and sale manager assume no liability for any accidents that may occur. Neither does the seller or sale manager

assume any liability for loss or injury to livestock due to theft, mysterious disappearance, sickness, improper handling or Act of God. It is to be clearly understood that the sale manager and its representatives act only as a medium between the buyer and seller.

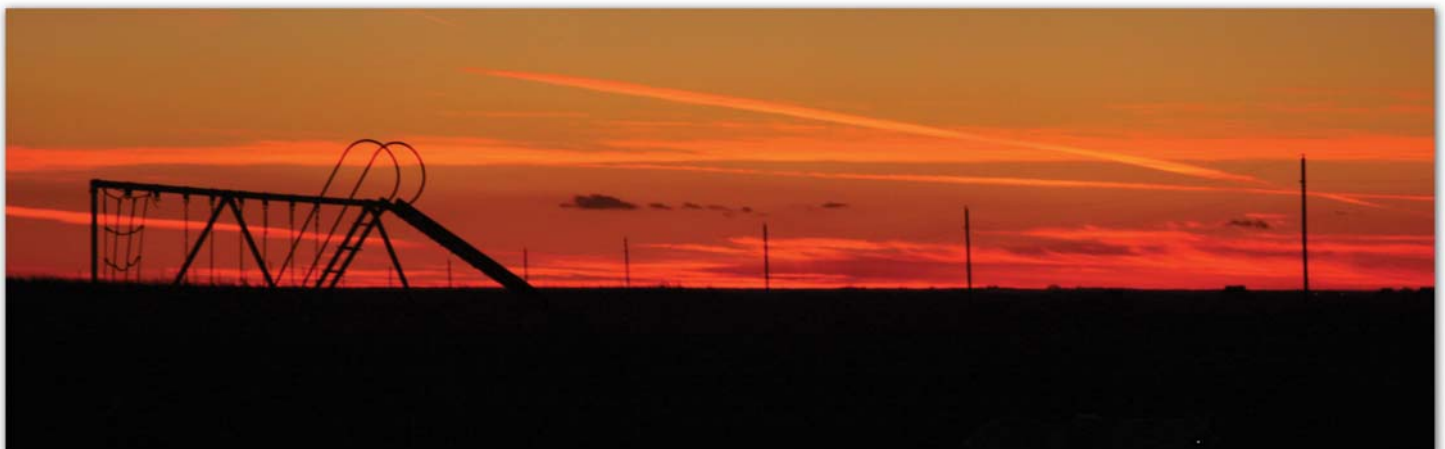
