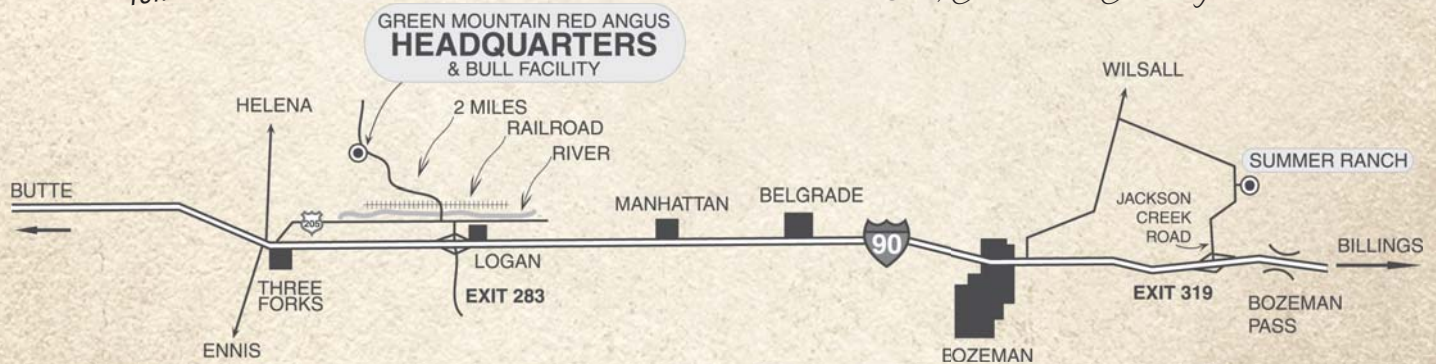

The road immediately crosses the Gallatin River and the railroad tracks, as shown on the map. Green Mountain Red Angus is 2 miles from the railroad tracks. Watch for the large Green Mountain Red Angus sign.
